Registration Requirements for New Students/Parents 2018-2019

The International School of Cambridge welcomes students from any ethnic, racial backgrounds, or faiths. The most important point is to ensure that any student accepted is capable of handling a strong academic curriculum successfully. Acceptance at the International School of Cambridge involves a selective process to maintain the high-quality services of the school.

Parents are required to provide the following documents:

- Completed Registration Form
- Signed ISOC Financial Agreement and a void cheque
- Copies of last year's final report card and current year's report card
- Completed Medical Form
- Copy of immunization record
- Health card
- Copy of the Birth Certificate or PR Card or Passport
- Signed Parental Enrolment Contract

Upon submitting the above documents, the applicants will be invited to come to the school for an administrative interview and may be asked to write an assessment in English and Math for students applying for Grades 2 to 8.

Once these steps are completed, a decision on acceptance will be made and mailed to each applicant's parent/Guardian. The decision to admit a new student is made by the International School of Cambridge Admission Council and will be based on a number of factors.

- Written Assessment (if required)
- Interview with the applicant and parent(s)
- Previous report cards
- Previous school's referral
