High School Registration Requirements for New Students/Parents

Academic Year 2020-2021

The International School of Cambridge welcomes students from any ethnic, racial background, or faith. The most important point is to ensure that any student accepted is capable of handling a strong academic curriculum successfully. Acceptance at the International School of Cambridge involves a selective process to maintain the high quality services of the school.

Parents are required to provide the following:

At the time of Registration:

- ❖ Registration Form
- ❖ Payment of Entrance Fee

At the time of Enrolment

- ❖ Enrolment Contract
- ❖ Copy of previous year's final report card or current year's last report card
- ❖ Copy of immunization record
- ❖ Copy of Health card
- ❖ Copy of child's Birth Certificate, PR Card or Passport
- ❖ Financial Agreement Form
- ❖ Payment of Materials Fee and EQAO Fee

Upon registration and payment of the Entrance Fee, the child will be given a date to write the Entrance Exam. The decision to admit a new student is made by the International School of Cambridge Administration and will be based on several factors:

- ❖ Entrance Exam
- ❖ Interview with the child and parent(s)
- ❖ Previous report cards

Once the exam is completed, a decision on acceptance will be communicated to each child's parent/guardian. At that time, the child's parent/guardian will be asked to come into the school to complete enrolment and pay the Materials and EQAO fees (See High School Fees Structure).
